Purpose & Vision

Calvary Chapel Kelowna Bible School was established to serve as a means for students to come and be equipped by the Word of God. We are here to obey our Lord Jesus Christ's command to go into all the world and make disciples of all nations. Our desire is to see men and women's lives changed by the power of God's Word through His Spirit and, being changed, to see them obey the Great Commission and go out. Our purpose could be summed up with three verses out of II Timothy. We desire for students to know whom they have believed (1:12); for students to be taught in the Word and then be able to teach

others (2:2); and to train students to be diligent workers, who have no need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth (2:15).

Our vision here at Calvary Chapel Kelowna Bible School is guided by the aforementioned purpose. We desire to see students grow in their knowledge and love of God and His Word and to see them practically live out their faith. Our hope is to see every student become involved and equipped in ministry when they leave. Campus Life

Student housing is just a short bike ride from the church and a short walk to beautiful Lake Okanagan. Students will live in dormitory style rooms in the Koinonia house and share a kitchen and bathroom. Additional living space is available but space is limited, so it is best to send your application as soon as possible. **Your place for the upcoming semester is not secure until we receive your deposit. Another applicant may be given your place if we receive their deposit before yours.**

Important Information

What to bring when you come:

- **Books:** required textbooks can be purchased before coming or at a local bookstore. Total costs for textbooks should not be more than \$150/170
- **Clothes:** Please bear in mind that we have 4 full seasons here in Kelowna so bring the appropriate clothing for the semester you will be attending.
- **MP3 Player:** As a part of your Biblical study, you will be listening to Pastor Chuck Smith on MP3 (Chuck Tracks). We recommend you bring an mp3 player to listen to them.
- **Computer:** We encourage you to bring your laptop computer for those who have them. We have limited space available for desktop computers so please check with us before you decide to bring one with you.
- **Bedding:** We will provide you with your bedding, however if you have a special bedding that you prefer, we encourage you to bring it.

Please keep in mind that we have a limited amount of space, so bring only what you need.

Guidelines for Campus Life:

- Students will be living in the Koinonia House in dormitory style rooms that house 2

people each. Keep in mind that students do not choose roommates

-Students of the opposite sex are not allowed to visit in the dorm rooms.

-We ask that you keep your room clean and personal items in order, out of respect for your room mate.

-CCKBS is not responsible for lost or stolen valuables.

-Don't use another student's personal belongings without their permission

-The staff is available to assist you in any prayer needs or counseling you may require. We understand that spiritual warfare is a major obstacle to students while in Bible School; this is why we are available to you for prayer day and night.

-Devotions are held Monday through Thursday. Students will meet before class (8:30 through 9:00) for a short time of worship and devotion shared by a student or staff member.

-Besides classroom learning, each student will be involved in serving in some practical areas such as volunteering in community service and/or serving the local body.

-On campus students are required to:

Attend the Friday night "Young Adults", attend on CC Kelowna on Sunday, and be involved in some area of ministry at CC Kelowna.

Leaving Campus & Weekend Travel: For accountability purposes, students will be required to fill out a travel voucher if leaving for one or more days.

Curfew & Noise: Students are required to be in the house by 12 midnight during the week, and 2am on the weekend. At 10pm during the week the house will be quite so students can study or sleep.

Moral Code

The following things ***are not permitted*** while attending CC Kelowna Bible School:

- 1 Drinking of alcohol on or off campus
- 2 The use of recreational drugs
- 3 Smoking cigarettes
- 4 Students of the opposite sex in a dorm room, without staff permission
- 5 Foul language

Student Relationships:

-Clothing: Dress appropriately and modestly. The staff reserves the right to determine the appropriateness of a person's dress. Do not wear clothing that will stumble your brother or sister or misrepresent Christ to the community.

We know that some Christians feel the liberty to practice some of these things. The concern guiding this rule is not primarily your personal righteousness, but how you get along with and affect others in the Bible School. We don't want to stumble others or draw undue attention to fleshly appearances. We want to draw people's attention to the beauty of Jesus and His love and be extra gracious to our Canadian community. We want to simply apply the heart Paul spoke of in 1 Corinthians 9:19: *For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win the more.*

-Obtaining Money: The local banks and ATMs will let you draw money from your bank account, however be aware of the service charges.

-Laundry: Machines on campus available for use and students will be assigned a schedule to do their laundry.

- Local outreaches: Plan to participate locally and a few hours away.

- Receiving packages: Students may receive packages at the dorm house, but be aware of shipping costs that will apply to the receiver, or you.

Courses Offered

Courses change from semester to semester. Extension campuses are geared toward 3rd and 4th semester students, however if you are a 1st or 2nd semester student, you should be on track to graduate with the classes we offer. You will need to email the school or check the website to check on the classes offered for the semester you choose to attend. Expectations

Attendance Policy

Calvary Chapel Kelowna Bible College requires 100 percent attendance for all classes. Classes are conducted in a manner that will encourage academic excellence and the growth of Christian character. The final authority for attendance rests with the Registrar.

Whenever an absence occurs (for whatever reason) the student must make up the class. For all absences, students need to fill out the Absence Authorization Form available from the teacher or TA. This completed form, a one page summary of the made-up class, and any homework that was due is to be turned in to the teacher, TA, or office within two weeks of the absence.

All Absences will incur a penalty

1. If the class is made-up by MP3, the penalty is a one increment grade deduction. (i.e. A to A-, A- to B+, etc.)
2. If the class is not made up, the penalty is a one letter grade deduction. (i.e. A to B, B to C, etc.)

In the event of excessive absences due to illness and/or family emergencies, the student may need to withdraw from school and return the following semester when his or her health/situation improves.

*Emergencies will be handled on a case-by-case basis through the Registrar's Office.

Tardies

For every two tardies there will be a one increment grade deduction.

Graduation Requirements

Programs of Study:

As a ministry of Calvary Chapel Kelowna we are not an accredited Bible school, but simply an extension of the church body dedicated to equipping the saints with knowledge of God's Word to do the work of the ministry. "And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the

equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.” However, not being accredited in any way, our credits are accepted by Calvary Chapel Bible College, Murrieta who is authorized by the Bureau of Post-Secondary and Private Vocational Education to issue degrees. CCBC Murrieta issues both Associate in Theology and Bachelor of Biblical Studies degrees when their standards for graduation are met as laid down by the BPPVE.

Bachelor of Biblical Studies:

This program is for the student who has successfully completed at least 60 transferable semester credits or 90 transferable quarter credits distributed over several disciplines as outlined by our articulation policy. The students must take all of the required courses (80 semester credits earned at CCBC or approved campus) and pass each class with a grade of “C” or better, maintaining a grade point average of 2.0 or better.

Associate in Theology:

This program is for the student who has successfully completed high school or its equivalent, but does not have the minimum transferable credits required for the Bachelor degree program. The student must take all of the required courses (80 credits earned at CCBC or approved campus) and pass with a grade of “C” or better, maintaining a grade point average of 2.0 or better.

Certificate of Completion:

This program was designed for the student who does not hold a high school diploma, or who has learning or language difficulties which prevent him or her from succeeding at college level work. The student must complete all of the required courses, on a pass/fail basis and must receive a grade “P” in a total of 80 semester credits at CCBC.

Accreditation

As a ministry of Calvary Chapel Kelowna we are not an accredited Bible school, but simply an extension of the local church body dedicated to equipping the saints with knowledge of God’s Word to do the work of the ministry. “And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.” However, not being accredited in any way, our credits are accepted by and completely transferable to Calvary Chapel Bible College, Murrieta who is authorized by the Bureau of Post-Secondary and Private Vocational Education to issue degrees.
